 Sunhats or caps if desired

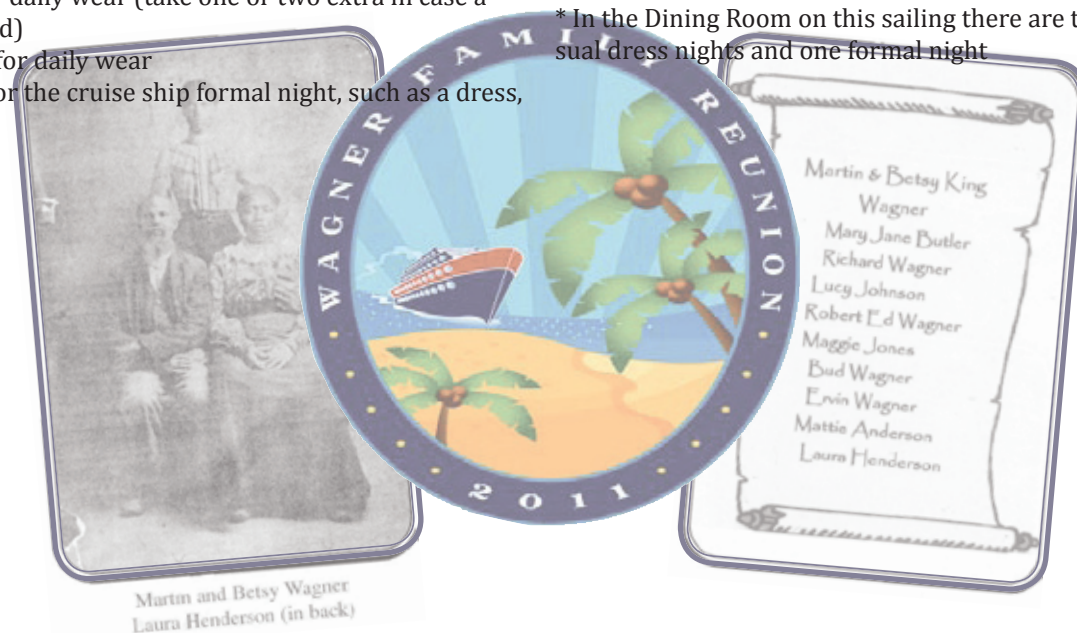
Electronics:

Excursion Information

Tour of Historical Nassau

Per Person Cost \$37.50

Come let the sons and daughters of the soil give you an extensive view of New Providence Island and Paradise Island through the eyes of a native. Drive through old romantic Nassau and environs to see our ancient forts Fincastle and Charlotte with their pirate lore. March or crawl down the Queen’s staircase, 65 steps cut out of natural limestone by slaves in the late 18th century. Enjoy the government buildings of Parliament Square, constructed in 1815 and excellent examples of colonial architecture. The Houses of Assembly, the old Colonial Secretary’s Office and the Supreme Court are clustered around a statue of Queen Victoria. Take a snap-shot of Government House, the official residence of the Queen’s personal representative, the Governor General, with its statue of Christopher Columbus in the foreground. Picturesque Gregory’s Arch, the Water Tower, the old prison, the unique native straw market, and scores of other historic sites in the centuries-old capital of the Bahamas await you during this informative tour of our capital.

This special package includes a three and a half hour fully narrated tour of Down-Town Nassau and parts of our country side. You can see all the historical landmarks left from pirates, slaves, and the first inhabitants of the island. We can take you to see residential areas from lower income classes to upper income classes as well as other prominent sites. While on Paradise Island, you can tour the world famous Atlantis Resort and Casino.

Atlantis Aqua Adventure Water Park

Per Person Cost \$115.00

Drive approximately 25-minutes through Nassau, as you make your way to the world-renowned Atlantis Resort on Paradise Island. Then, dive into the magic of Atlantis’ newest 141-acre treasure: Aquaventure waterscape. Featuring state-of-the-art water slides, river rapids, waterfalls, water holes and amazing special effects, Aquaventure is far from your usual water park. Just hop in your own inner tube and sit back as you are propelled along a river to the main water attractions via a series of special escalators, waves and surge.

Take the plunge from one of the four thrilling water slides of the 120-foot tall Power Tower. Plunge into the Abyss — a near-vertical 50 feet drop through a tumbling waterfall into total darkness — before finding yourself submerged in a deep cenote filled with Alligator Gars. Coast along the bouncy inner tube slides of The Drop, The Falls and The Surge and then catch some white-water waves at The Rapids. It’s all up to you! Visit the luxurious casino — awash with decorative glass sculptures that jet into the sky — and try your luck at slots, blackjack or craps; or, spend some time shopping in the upscale Marina Village.

Important Additional Information about Aqua Adventure:

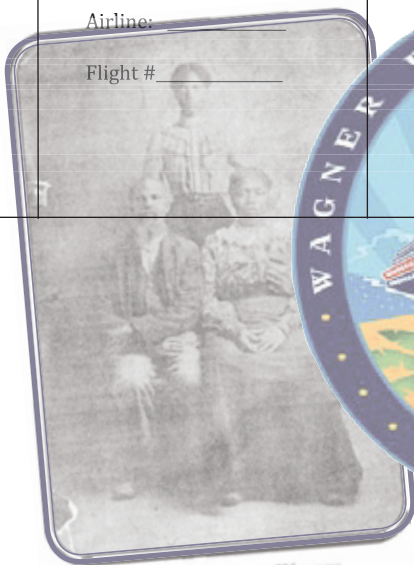
- This excursion includes an approximate 15-minute walk to and from the pick-up point and a minimum of 0.5 miles of walking at Atlantis. Because of this, Guests are encouraged to wear comfortable walking shoes.
- Guests must be at least 48” tall to ride all water slides. Children less than 48” tall may participate at Splasher’s, Atlantis’ children’s water playground, and on the Aquaventure river systems.
- Children must be accompanied by an adult on a double tube, wear a life vest (provided free of charge and be large enough to support themselves in the inner tube opening).
